## **Background**

The Environmental Managers' Association of BC (EMA of BC) is a non-profit organization formed to encourage education, share knowledge among members and create a forum for environmental management issues in the industrial, commercial and institutional sectors. The EMA of BC intends to grant \$2,500 to a BC based non-profit environmental organization working to enhance or protect the environment. The grant will be awarded at our annual workshop scheduled for early 2007.

We will be selecting a relatively small group that operates solely in British Columbia with volunteers who work on project(s) that help sustain or improve the natural environment, and would attain considerable benefits from this donation. We will be requiring that the donation be used for physical/tangible works that exhibit positive environmental benefits (such as riparian enhancement or posting educational signage). Administrative costs will not be accepted as a use for this funding. Previous recipients of the EMA of BC grant are not eligible for this year's donation.

## **Proposals**

Proposals should be no longer than two pages and include a minimum of the following information.

- Name of the organization applying for the funding
- Mission of the organization
- Current initiatives/activities
- Specifically what the grant would be used for
- Other sources of funding the organization has received in the past two years
