Through our monthly meetings, members have discussed numerous topics including: Environmental Auditing, Risk Control and Environmental Insurance, Managing Air Quality in Greater Vancouver, Review and Recent Developments in Environmental Regulation and Due Diligence Law, Hazardous Waste Management, Energy Conservation and Management, What To Do If You Are Charged with an Offence Under the Waste Management Act. *(See attached Sample List of Topics.)*

- Our monthly meetings focus on guest speakers and provide an interactive perspective.
- Networking among members provides a platform for the sharing of vital communication and practical information, for example, “what worked and what didn’t work”.
